NEW Calgary City FC KIT

Gear Requirements:

Each player must have their shin pads and appropriate footwear for soccer.

For grassroots programs (U7 to U9), we have sponsorship from Tim Hortons and Shane Homes, which provide us with the players' uniforms.

Players new to the team or moving up to U10 will be required to purchase a CCFC Kit (\$150).

The kit includes a backpack, two jerseys (home and away), shorts, socks, a hoodie, and a training T-shirt (red or white). The set is mandatory – all players must wear the proper gear, with no exceptions, and players will keep the whole kit.



Education fee:

The \$15 education fee covers costs for our team officials' training, such as Respect in Sport, National Coaching Certification Program courses, coach licenses, and development.

Facility:

A \$15 facility fee will be added to all registrations. Calgary City FC plans to have own facility for its players. This fee will be used solely for facility development. Please visit our website for more details about the project.

HOW TO REGISTER

- 1) To [register](#) for a program, visit [Calgary City FC](#) and click on the program that you want to register
- 2) Create a Otto Sports account under your name - Parent/Guardian
- 3) Add a player – each player in your family needs to be added individually
- 4) Click on Register Now and pick the product you want to register your player in
- 5) Once you have added all the products you want to register, click on “Add to Basket”
- 6) Enter the promo code if applicable and click on “Update Basket”
- 7) Click on “Check Out”
- 8) Complete the waiver(s)
- 9) Choose a payment method
- 10) Complete payment

Please note you only need one account per family. You do not need to create a new account if you already have an account and have registered previously.

REFUNDS

All refund requests go to info@calgarycityfc.ca

- An Administration fee applies and will be deducted from all refunds. Grassroots (Under U9) \$50 and CMSA U10 and up \$100
- There will be **NO** refunds granted or issued after **September 10, 2025**
- The timeline for receiving a refund will be 8 weeks from receipt of the refund request.

DEADLINES

Non-injury-related refunds deadline is before **September 10, 2025**

Injury-related (with a doctor's note): Refunds might be offered on a case-by-case basis to be determined by the cost already incurred in the program.

Moving/relocating (with proof). Refunds might be offered on a case-by-case basis to be determined by the cost already incurred in the program.

CONDITIONS FOR REFUND

Will ONLY be considered under the following circumstances:

- Request is received before the deadline of **September 10, 2025**
- For non-injury-related requests - the player has not yet been placed on a team.
- Change in family circumstances, by moving out of the city or country.
- Injury to a player that will be medically deemed unable to play for the remainder of the season, accompanied by a doctor's note.

Goals of the Shane Homes Grassroots League

CMSA's Grassroots League, sponsored by Shane Homes, is modelled after national and international best practices and **Calgary Minor Soccer Association League Standards** with a developmentally appropriate playing environment that allows expression, creativity, and development to flourish. Match Day provides players with more time on the field, more time on the ball, and flexible matchups through an open roster system.

This league encourages mixed-ability (balanced) groupings prioritizing social relationships as the basis of Match Day groups. This allows players to move between groups as required to ensure that each participant has a positive and developmentally appropriate match environment. The Shane Homes Grassroots League prioritizes enjoyment, so players want to come back next week and more importantly, for many seasons to come!

CMSA U10 and U11 League

Developmental Plus+ and Developmental

CMSA's U10 and U11 League has a 'Developmental Plus+' and 'Developmental' stream. Both streams offer a quality experience for players and their families. **Neither stream is purely based on ability but on the needs, interests, and motivations of the child.** The determining factors in evaluating whether to place groups in the "Developmental Plus+" or "Developmental" streams are the length of the season and the proximity of their matches. "Developmental Plus+" will play in a city - wide division and have a longer, split format. "Developmental" will have regionalized play with a shorter season. In this player-first model, clubs are encouraged to evaluate players based on their levels of interest and commitment in soccer and utilize social relationships (friendships) as a key factor in forming teams.

CMSA advocates for equal playing time for all players and to try all positions on the pitch. No scores or standings are kept in the Developmental Plus+ or Developmental stream.
